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ANNUAL ACTIVITY REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2018-2019.

SPANDANA EDUCATIONAL SOCIAL AND CULTURAL ORGANISATION (R) was set up as a non-profit charitable trust that would mobilize public opinion and generate resources for supporting development action. The founders recognized the right of rural community to lead a life of dignity and Self-respect in a just and equitable Society; and the need to improve the capacities of individuals and communities to improve the quality of their lives and enhance their ability to negotiate from the position of strength. A strength that would come from being educated, in good health and having the capacity to be engaged in productive work.

In the last few decades, voluntary organisations and community groups have emerged as strategic players on the development scheme. Many of them base their work on the emerging needs of the community however, unlike other organisations, which focus their efforts on sectoral programmes, the foundation supports long-term development initiatives that arise out of the felt needs of the people. The foundation recognizes that the process of development is as important as the outcome. Within the above framework, the foundation is committed to work towards a synergy of different input as being necessary for a people centered development strategy.

1. NON-FORMAL EDUCATION PROGRAMME:

The Mandya District has completed total Literacy campaign & initiated “Continuing Education Programme” to Sustain the interest & learning ability of illiterates. The Organisation is providing the motivational inputs to the CESC of project villages, through their Prerakas and Sub-Prerakas. This is one of the regular activities where the need-assessment studies of illiterates are also conducted so as to increase the interest of the illiterates. The total amounts spend for this programme for the year 2011 is Rs29,990.

2. FORMAL EDUCATION PROGRAMME:

Providing basic education to the rural school going children community is the main objective of the organization. So, that organization is kept on putting collective efforts to conduct quality education to the rural poor school going children. Another important

3. WOMEN SELF-HELP GROUP TRAINING PROGRAMME:

Women has a vital role in both family and community development and local government having different programme for women empowerment, but our rural women folk were not coming out from their family and society to understand the concept of the programme and its benefit towards women empowerment schemes like "Strishakthi" and women swavalambana programme in connection to that our organization has conducted women empowerment training programme for our organized self-help groups and Strishakthi women group members. The training programme was organized 2 days each from 13th to 14th February 2019 to 27th to 28th February 2019 at Mangala and Sundahally respectively. Totally 67 women group representatives were under gone this training, we were discussed issues like savings, selection of benefits, loan disbursement government shares and programme. Book-keeping and roles and responsibilities of women in family and community development. The total amounts spend for this programme for the year 2008 is Rs.43,320-00.

4. VOCATIONAL TRAINING PROGRAMME:

1.1 **SCREEN PRINTING AND PAPER CONSERVATION** : The organization conducted the Screen Printing and Paper Conservation programme at Sundahally village of Mandya taluka with assistance of the local resources. 30 Women SC/ST and OBC beneficiaries identified and selected among widows and physically handicapped women who are deserved for the training. The training course was three months and training programme was started from 01.06.2010 and concluded on 30.08.2018

1.2.**TAILORING AND EMBROIDARY TRAINING PROGRAMME** : The Tailoring and Embroidery Training programme was organised by the organization with sponsorship of Micro-Small and Medium Enterprises, Bangalore the programme was conducted at Guttalu town of Mandya District for 30 Schedule Tribe poor rural and needy women from villages of our project area. The training programme was for one month ten days (40 Days), the Training programme was started on 01.11.2018 and concluded on 09.12.2018

1.3.**COMPUTER-TRAINING PROGRAMME** : Organisation was conducted three months training programme on basic computer from 01st January 2019 to 30 March 2019. The training was organized at Mangala village of Mandya taluk. Imparted basic computer education to 15 men and 10 women trainees and were benefited from the programme.

The above training programmes were organized and conducted by the organization due to improve the skill of the men and women of the rural area. So that rural women folk and youths will get an opportunity to get an employment and ultimately the socio-economic condition of these target group families to be improved an a greater extent . The total amount spend for this programme for the year 2019 is Rs 38,650/-

5. DRY LAND DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME:

Most of our farmers are having dry land and depending on rain and doing agricultural operation. Due to climatical changes the rain fall is not getting in time. So organisation keeping this in mind an awareness programme on dry land development has been initiated in all most all the project villages. The total amounts spend for this programme for the year 2019 is Rs.17,570-00

6. WATERSHED MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME:

Soil erosion was common in rural area and farmers were not aware about the watershed techniques and managements to control the soil erosion. So that organization is continuing efforts to control the soil erosion at maximum eater by creating awareness on this subject and constructing the check dam by local available resources. As a demonstration a check dam was constructed at Bevanahally village of Mandya taluk with the help of local village community and village development association. The total amount spend for this programme for the year 2019 is Rs.15,960-00

7. CONSUMER AWARENESS PROGRAMME:

It is necessary to inform the rural population who are unaware of the state and central Government programmes and the benefits of the schemes. The awareness programme is intend to make likely beneficiaries aware of their rights and enthuse local administration to play a more pro-active role, having this in mind the mass consumer awareness camps were organized in entire project area through public meetings, functions and group discussions a special awareness is given to the rural women to ensure the steps while purchasing the essential the domestic goods. The total amounts spend for this programme for the year 2019 is Rs.18, 425-00.

8. VORMI COMPOST TRAINING PROGRAMME:

Our rural farmers community are depending on chemical fertilizers and pesticides which leads kinds of deserves and effecting much more on normal human life. So this practice has to be changed. Keeping the factor in mind organization has conducted a wormiculture training programme to be selected forum from different villages of Bangalore Rural district and conducted 3 days each of two training programmes at Karasavadi and Mangala villages from 17-08-2018 to 19-08-2018 and practical training programme an alternate and its usage of worm campus to get more yield and control the diseases which are spreading. The total amount spends for this programme for the year 2019 is Rs 13,940.00

9. SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PROGRAMME:

The town Municipal of Nagamangala is not having proper disposal solid work and due this conical diseases spreads to this local community not aware about organization has conducted a two days work shop on 15th January to 16th January 2008 at Nagamangala Municipal Karmacharis, SHG members and youth group members were participated in this programme segregation in of waste in, 3 types like Dry, Green and Lazard waste and its proper disposal was the subjects were discussed. The total amount spend for this programme for the year 2019 is Rs.9,360.00.

10. RAIN HARVEST DEMO/TRAINING PROGRAMME:

The programme was continued in the reporting year due to rain is not receiving properly in these days and the scheduled of the rain keep on changing year by year due to the climatical changes in solar system and storage of the rain water is not taken place and all rainwater flowing out side, so keeping this in mind organization stared awareness programme in our project all project village through demonstration cum training programme The total amount spends for this programme for the year 2011 is Rs.8,760.00

11. RURAL SPORTS AND CULTURAL PROGRAMME:

The programme was continued in the reporting period and the 2 days cultural and sports meet was held at Gejjalagere village of Mandya taluk on 15th to 16th October 2018 was organized, both men and women were participated in the programme community is actively involved. Conducted separate programme for school children and prizes given to the talented personalities. Same day a debate competition was organized. Management committee members and the official form education department and the local leaders participated and cultural awareness was created among the participants. The total amount spends for this programme for the year 2019 is Rs.7.810.00

12. HIV/AIDS PREVENTION PROGRAMME:

The HIV/AIDS & CANCER is rapidly growing decease which can be presented through proper education and our rural community has not having much knowledge about this dangerous us diseases. So organization as conducted a taluk level workshop on 19-03-2011 to 21-03-2011 for 3 days and identified 30 youths and school teachers were given all related education having an idea that there participants in turn spread the mass awareness in rural area, so that this can be presented to reach to our rural community. 10,350-00 was spent on this programme for 2019.

13. CHILD LABOUR PROGRAMME:

During the school enrolment in generally, the rural people are not in favour to sending female children to school and some families feel that instead of sending the male children to school, they can send them for work in anticipation; they can get some additional income to their family. In this juncture organisation feels to create awareness among the rural community, to avoid child labours and dropouts can be enrolled in the formal education, so that they can learn read and write. A campaign was organized on May 25th 2010 followed by an awareness camps organised in 10 project villages on the last week of May 2007, along with school children, local youth groups and women groups. The total amount spends for this programme for the year 2019 is Rs11,800.00

EVALUVATION OF THE PROGRAMS:

Usually evaluation was done quarterly, half yearly and at the end of the year through our field staff and experts from out side, by involving community. Apart from these evaluations a separate evaluation was conducted at end of each activity. Focus will also be made to motivate the community to approach Financial Institutions, Government department, political bodies and other agencies to meet the infrastructures and developmental requirements of their activities for the total Socio-Economic development of the target group families in particular and community as a hole.
